
Liability acknowledgment for shipments of goods equipped with lithium batteries

By submitting a claim for products containing lithium batteries, the submitter acknowledges and accepts the inherent risks of shipping such products, especially if the batteries are damaged or exposed. Lithium batteries may pose a fire or explosion hazard if damaged or handled improperly.

The submitter is aware that it is the responsibility of the shipper to take all necessary precautions, such as, but not exclusively proper and safe packaging and proper labeling in accordance with safety guidelines.

The shipper of the goods is fully responsible for any damage, loss or incident that may occur as a result of his negligence.
